

# Northern Shenandoah Valley Master Gardeners Association 2016 Memorial High School Scholarship Information Sheet



The Northern Shenandoah Valley Master Gardeners Association (NSVMGA), will award five \$200 scholarships to promising 2016 graduating seniors. Eligible students must have attended a high school or home school program in one of the following Virginia counties: Clarke, Warren, Shenandoah, Frederick, or Page; and must have been accepted into an accredited Virginia college, university, or community college. One \$200 scholarship will be awarded to a student in each of the five counties.

The NSVMGA Scholarship Review Committee will base the awards on scholastic merit as well as participation in an agricultural, horticultural or science based community service organization. Students will be asked to submit an application, meet the application criteria and submit all required documents no later than the **March 1, 2016** deadline.

**NSVMGA's goal is to help develop horticultural leaders in Virginia. The primary purpose of the scholarship is to encourage Shenandoah Valley high school students to continue their studies in a horticulturally related field while attending college and to volunteer and support their communities.**

**Scholarship application packets will be sent to all local high schools and the application information will also be available on-line. Application information can be downloaded from the NSVMGA website located at: [www.nsvmga.org](http://www.nsvmga.org) .**

Criteria for the scholarship includes an overall 3.0 GPA and submission of an official copy of the student's high school transcript.
