DESCRIPTION

This plant grows best in wet, well-drained soils. Soil should not dry out. This is the tallest of native American lilies. Lance-shaped to elliptic leaves, up to 6" long, are whorled around the stems. Downward nodding Turk's cap-type orange flowers appear early to mid spring and are spotted with maroon dots.
