Description

Generally, are hardy, easy to grow and relatively trouble free. Fine textured strap like leaves. Dependable plants for the garden not bothered by common iris pests. They require moist, well drained soils in sun to light shade. Will tolerate wet sites. Native to central and eastern Europe, Siberian Iris generally blooms in shades of bluish-purple. Division is rarely necessary for Siberian irises; divide when clumps become crowded or when flowering decreases. There are numerous varieties.
