Tuberous perennial, Zones 6-7



Description

This plant, also known as the hardy begonia, is tuberous-rooted, clump forming, perennial that forms a bushy mound of foliage. Large ovate leaves are medium to olive green above and reddish green with red veining beneath. Male and female, pink, blooms up to 1" across bloom in clusters from July to early Fall. Mix well in shaded areas with ferns and hostas. No serious insect or disease problems. Deadhead flowers to extend the blooming period.
