Description

Hydrangea paniculata, also known as Panicked Hydrangea is a rapidly growing woody perennial that is one of the most winter hardy hydrangea. It is a multi-stemmed deciduous shrub but can be trained to grow as a single trunk tree. It blooms July through September (one of the later garden blooms) with clusters of flowers initially creamy white fading to pinkish rose. This hydrangea variety also prefers more sun than most others and is resistant to drought. It has shallow roots and will benefit from 2-3" of mulch. It attracts pollinators and also small mammals which use it for cover. It is susceptible to deer damage as well as its brittle stems being damaged by high winds. Insect problems are rare but it is susceptible to some diseases.
