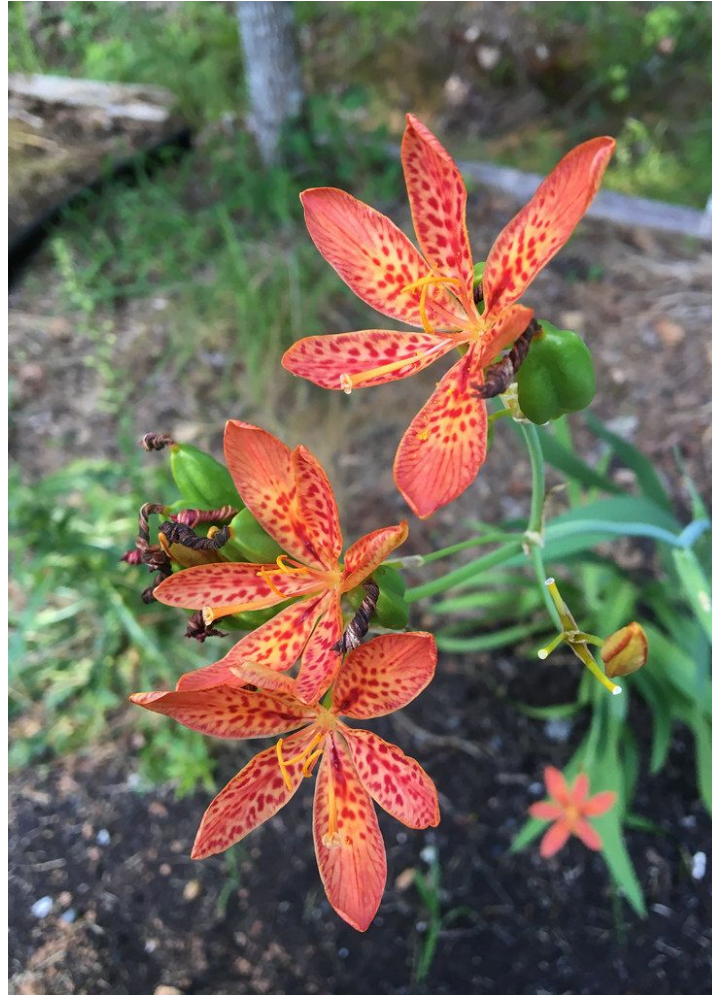
Herbaceous Perennial, zones 5-10

Description

This plant has lily-like, showy, orange flowers with red dots that bloom July–August. The sprays of flowers are above sword-shaped iris-like leaves (up to 10" long) in flattened fans. Flowers die back to reveal pear-shaped seed pods which split open when ripe, showing a blackberry-like seed cluster. Spreads by rhizomes, but in optimal conditions will spread by seed.
