DESCRIPTION

This plant loves dry to medium, alkaline, and well-drained soil. Showy, fragrant, purple flowers appear along terminal spikes late spring to early summer. Fragrant blossoms and leaves may be dried and used in sachets and potpourris. Fragrant leaves are narrow, gray-green up to 2.5 long. Prune to 8" in spring every 3 years to control size and promote new growth.
