DESCRIPTION

Also known as yellow poplar, this tree has alternate palmately veined, 4 lobed, bright green leaves with smooth margins that turn golden yellow in the fall. Blossoms appear from May to June and are yellow with an orange band at the base of the petal. The mature tree shape is pyramidal to broad conical. These fast growing trees tend to be weak-wooded. Disease problems can include: verticillium wilt, mold, mildew, and canker. Also susceptible to infestations of aphids and scale.
