Description

This native plant features tubular, two-lipped, bright scarlet-red flowers that bloom for about 8 weeks from early/mid-summer to late summer. Attractive to bees, hummingbirds, and butterflies. Powdery mildew can be a serious problem. If the soil is allowed to dry out, the stressed plant can be susceptible to disease. Deer and rabbits ten to avoid this plant.
