Description

This plant has showy, fragrant pink-purple to white flowers that bloom from July to September which attract butterflies, hummingbirds, and birds. Does not tolerate drought so will need to be watered in dry spells. Does tolerate deer, clay soil, and black walnut. Mulch in the summer to keep roots cool. Phlox bugs, powdery mildew, and root rot can be serious problems. In hot, dry conditions spider mites may be an issue. Use in a perennial border.
