

LAMBS' EARS *STACHYS BYZANTINA*

Herbaceous perennial, Zones 4-8



DESCRIPTION

Tolerates rabbit, deer, drought, rocky soil, and black walnut. Spreads by creeping stems. The leaf shape and soft texture resembles a lamb's ear. Flowers from May to July, and the stems can be cut back to maintain a low profile. Can be used as edging or as a ground cover. No serious insect or disease problems.
