 Description

Oenothera speciosa, also known as Pink Ladies and Pink (or White, or Showy) Evening Primrose since its flowers open in the evening and remain open until morning. It is an herbaceous perennial that grows easily in full sun but can tolerate some part shade in the afternoon. It blooms May through July with showy white bowl shaped (2-3") flowers that mature to a rosy pink. It can be grown from seed outdoors planted in either fall or early spring. It spreads aggressively by rhizomes and self-seeding forming large colonies. It also tolerates poor soils and drought and has no serious insect or disease problems.
